

Emergency Preparedness - Alternate Holding Areas

In the event that the building is evacuated for any reason, the Foundation has arrangements made for alternate holding areas. Once everyone is accounted for outside the building, residents and staff will be transported to another nearby facility.

Should evacuation of geographical area (for example: downtown) be declared, the alternate holding areas will be locations outside of the evacuation area.
