Emergency Preparedness - *Fraud Prevention*

March is Fraud Prevention month. Take precautions to protect yourself. Unless you have initiated contact to a business, never give out your credit card number over the phone. Don't give your pin numbers or passwords to anyone.

Some of the common scams being used are:

- A caller advises you that you have won a lottery or sweepstakes but you need to pay for the handling fees and you can do so by providing your credit card number.
- A caller says they are your grandson or granddaughter and have been in an accident and need money.
- Revenue Canada threatens to call the police if you don't give them your credit card number to pay the amount you owe.

Scammers are smooth and cunning. They ask you leading questions to get information from you, then use that information to get even more personal information. If you receive a call that you are uncomfortable with, hang up and let your family, lodge Manager, or police know.
