#### **Accomodation Standards and Licensing**

Each year, the Foundation must reapply to the Government of Alberta to maintain our license to operate under the Accommodation Standards and Licensing. The focus of these Standards is the safety and security of our residents. During the month of January, the auditor will inspect each lodge to ensure we are meeting the 32 Standards which include hottest flowing water temperature logs, cleaning schedules, emergency processes, menus, medication assistance, and the overall condition of the lodge. Staff and Residents are spoken to as the auditor tours the lodge.

The Foundation has policies and procedures in place to achieve compliance. Please speak to your Manager if you have questions or want to learn more about the Licensing Standards.

#### Emergency Preparedness - Building Evacuation

In the event of the building must be evacuated, staff are trained in emergency response. Stay calm and make your way to the nearest emergency exit. Follow directions provided by staff. Ensure you know where the muster point is located and wait there for further direction. Once the building has been declared safe, you will be allowed to re-enter the building.
